The greater the number of sperms released the higher are the chances of a healthy sperm reaching the egg. In such a case, IVF is quite useful. It helps to manually unite the sperm and egg so that an embryo can be created outside in the test tube, which can later be inserted into the uterus of the woman. To conceive a baby, it is necessary that the uterus must be healthy. If there is some issue regarding the uterus, it becomes tough for woman to become pregnant. In such a case as well, In vitro fertilization process is perceived to be appropriate infertility treatment. In addition to the above mentioned conditions, there are some other instances as well in which in vitro fertilization is recommended.
